

## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION**

The registration fee for the 2011 Wisconsin State Public Defender Annual Conference is \$319 for two days or \$219 for one day if your registration form and payment is received in our office by **October 14, 2011**. Attorneys who are actively taking public defender cases are offered the reduced registration fee of **\$239** for two days or **\$139** for one day.
